

Professional Web FLV Player by Web Anatomy

Documentation part 2 (Video Management System)

1. Introduction

Video management system was built to help all our clients add/edit their videos and playlists easily. This system is ready to use right after completing the installation. You'll just have to make sure that 3rd video selecting method is turned on (Installation tab).

2. Adding a new Video :

In order to add a new video simply switch to Video Management tab in the Control Panel and select "Add new Video" page on the left side of your screen. You'll have to complete simple form now.

Video title - it'll appear on the top of the playlist & in Control Panel

Description Video - if you are using ad-networks like Google, Scanscout ect. this information is very important for analyzing your video. Description will also appear in the playlist right below the title.

Keywords - (optional) information required by some ad-networks

Small Thumb - small image (100px / 60px) for the playlist

Big Thumb - this image will cover the front of a player before starting a video (640px / 580 or more). If this picture is too small flash player might not resize it fully!

SD Video - standard and main path for your video. If you are not providing HD material this is the place where you have to put your path with video.

HD Video - link to a copy of SD Video in high definition (optional). You'll have to activate HD mode in style management system too!

Playlists - here you'll see a list of all available (created) playlist. You'll have to select at least one playlist for a movie. You can select more than 1 using "shift" button.

3. Editing/Deleting a Video & Generating Embedding code:

Now we'll try to edit one of our videos and generate an embedding code. Please switch to "List of Videos" page in Video Management tab. Here you'll find all your saved videos. As you probably have noticed some of them (with game trailers) has been here from start. On the right side of each position you'll find 3 buttons:

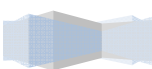
Edit Video - here you'll be able to change data of your videos

Get Code - after clicking here you'll see embedding code of your video. You can use copy and paste it wherever you want.

Delete - permanently removes specified video from a Database

3. Playlists

There are two ways how videos are selected for playlists. Each video belongs to at least one playlist. Whenever you start your player you'll see a list of positions which are related with the main video (belong to the same playlist). If you have selected more than one playlist per video - they will be mixed. You can always manually specify which playlist should appear in a player by adding one more variable to the embedding code:



Example:

In this way player will be forced to use specified playlist - you can attach more than one playlist , just like that:
